### End of Session Hot Topics & Bills

- Hot Labor Summer
  - Classified Employees: AB 1699 McCarty re: posting and filling vacancies; SB 433 Cortese re: disciplinary hearings, appeals & 3<sup>rd</sup> party hrng officers. Both bills VETOED
  - Adult Ed probationary employees permanent status AB 897 McCarty APPROVED
- School Transportation
  - SB 88 Skinner Driver Qualifications. APPROVED
  - AB 579 Ting Electric Schoolbuses (2035) APPROVED with signing message
- Curriculum and instructional materials selection AB 1078 Jackson APPROVED (urgency)
- Suspensions & Expulsions SB 274 Skinner prohibits use of willful defiance – APPROVED
- Hiring Flexibility Retired Certificated Staff SB 765 Portantino Awaiting Governor's Action as of 10/10
- School Bond Bills for 2024 Ballot AB 247 Muratsuchi (TK-14); SB 28 (Glazer) (PreK-Univ) held in Legislature; negotiations early 2024

# State Budget Outlook

#### State faced \$26 - \$30 billion Budget Deficit in 2023

- Actions to address deficit included reductions, delays, cost shifts, revenue-related, e.g., increase tax on health insurance plans.
- Did not use reserves to close the deficit.
- Despite deficit, TK-12 Education received 8.22% COLA, mitigated current year cuts, obtained extension of time on expenditure of ELOP

#### What's ahead for 2024-25?

- As of October 2023, forecast by LAO suggests upside for state revenues as compared to projections reflected in the 2023 Budget Act; but a \$10 billion deficit would remain
- LAO preliminary estimate of statutory COLA for 2024-25 of about 2%
- LAO -- Prop 98 remains in Test 1 (about 40%)
