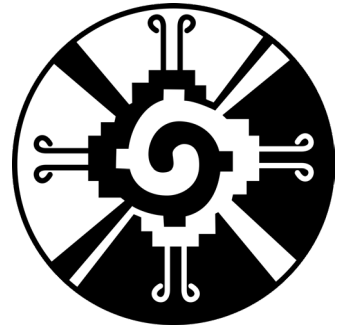

# History of Charter Process

- Spring 2020: Charter Renewed for a sixth five-year term, from July 1, 2020 - June 30, 2025
- This report contains data and analysis for 2022-23 school year



# Analysis of Progress Toward LCAP Goals

## **Goal 1: All Students engage in a broad, rigorous course of study**

- Academic Progress is higher in the start and end of the year - examining how we can address the middle two quarters
- Bilingual Learning Coaches continue to support all students
- Currently in the process of trying to hire another teacher



# Analysis of Progress Toward LCAP Goals

## **Goal 2: All students engage in learning experiences that strengthen their sense of belonging and future orientation**

- College of Marin Class - preparation for college and readiness
- Students connected with off campus learning for “electives” including work, field trips, and connection to CCR opportunities

## **Goal 3: Parent Involvement**

- High level of satisfaction in parent surveys
- Increased bilingual mental health services

# State and Local Assessments

- State assessment completion rates increased to 30% for 2022-23 school year
- Emphasis on ensuring local measures are valid and reliable



# Parent Involvement in Governance and Operations

- Working toward shared decision making through Community Schools process
- Regular School Site Council and English Learners Advisory Committee representation
- Surveys
- Regular parent events



# Overview of Admissions Process

- Admission open to all students who wish to enter the school and who live in the state of California.
- Intent to Enroll due each March - after Open House
- When full capacity is reached (160 students) we would hold a public random lottery
- Phoenix Academy operates in tandem with Marin's Community School





## Other Highlights



The Charter is in compliance with the following sections:

- Special Education and Section 504: Follow all state and federal law - guidance from MCOE and Marin Special Education Local Plan Areas (SELPA)
- Facilities: Comprehensive Maintenance and Operations Plan
- Suspension and expulsion policies: no change.
- Internal/External Disputes: none. Also, no parent complaints.
