## TOPIC: Creating cross district educational opportunities for students

- Megan Dunn, Special Education Director for the Larkspur-Corte Madera School District shared her district's experience with sharing Behavioral Specialist support services (serving students in general education and special education) with the Mill Valley School District.
- Members then went into breakout sessions to:
  - Identify cross district educational opportunities.
    - What is working well?
    - Where are opportunities for improvement?
  - Discuss areas that may be appropriate for cross district collaboration and how that can best happen.
- After two breakout sessions, members shared the following key topics that surfaced during discussion:
  - Middle School to High School alignment via shared professional services days between the schools
  - Professional development across districts;
  - Digital safety training for parents;
  - Shared universal lunch/nutrition programs;
  - Digital emergency notification systems;
  - Pre-K;
  - Protocols for new Trustees to learn about shared services from district Superintendents;
  - Math curriculum;
  - Career counseling;
  - Business services pipelines to develop talent internally;
  - Speech and language, and psychologist pipelines;
  - Shared music and arts programs;
  - Custodial services;
  - Outdoor education; and
  - Housing and growing enrollment.
