Members from the Pension Ad Hoc Committee shared the purpose and efforts of the Ad Hoc Committee which is to inform people on public pensions and what the education community can do to support pensions in California while understanding the impact our students and communities.

The Ad Hoc Committee shared a draft Pension Reform School District Resolution and discussed the various parts of the resolution. The objective of the resolution is to inform and bring awareness to all Marin county school districts that pensions need to be addressed beginning at county level to build the momentum to elevate the problem to the state level.

The next steps involve finalizing the Resolution and sharing with Superintendent's for presentation to their board for endorsement as early as Spring 2021.
