Under the current FAP, the base grant is allocated by ADA and the federal grant is allocated as described below As this allocation plan uses the same ADA as the prior year, year over year changes in the local grant are due to the slight increase in the total district distribution in comparison to the prior year. Overall, the increased cost of set-asides, notably for the out-of-home care program, and the decline in ADA, are completely offset by COLA.

#### Federal

Federal funding is based on the 2016-17 grant award of \$ 6,456,428 which includes | \$ 869,892 in grant funding for pre-school age children leaving \$ 5,586,536 for distribution through the FAP

New in 2018-19, the grant awarded for pre-school in resource 3320 will be rolled into the IDEA grant award in resource 3310 We understand the grant amount is to remain the same and we therefore propose treating it as a federal set-aside that is passed through to the Pre-school fiscal allocation plan.

Federal funds are allocated to all member LEAs including MCOE. 85% of the funds are allocated using prior year pupil counts. This FAP has been developed using District of Service pupil count from the December 1, 2017 certified count. The remaining 15% of the grant is allocated using the 2017-18 Fall 1 CALPADs count of low income pupils.
