2017 GOLDEN BELL AWARDSRECOGNITION INFORMATION

Recognition of Certificated Teachers

Background: Districts may select one outstanding certificated teacher per school for

recognition at the Golden Bell event.

Process: The procedure for selection will be at the discretion of individual districts.

Requirement: Districts must complete a *Certificated Teacher Selection Form* for each teacher

selected for recognition.

Recognition of Classified Support Staff

Background: Districts may select to honor outstanding classified support staff, administrative

assistants, paraeducators, or any other employees except certificated and administrative personnel. Please refer to the Nomination Allocation document which identifies the number of support staff honorees each district may select.

Process: The procedure for selection will be at the discretion of individual districts.

Requirement: Districts must complete a Support Staff Selection Form for each

classified/certificated support personnel selected for recognition.

Recognition of Educator of the Year

Background: Nominations may be a site, district, or county administrator. Factors that should

be taken into account include length of service, leadership in both the district and

in countywide efforts, and other honorable accomplishments.

Process: A district may nominate up to two educators. The awardee is selected by a

committee comprised of past award recipients.

Requirement: The Educator of the Year Nomination Form must be completed and submitted with

district support.

Recognition of Classified Employee of the Year

Background: Districts may select to honor exceptional classified employees.

Process: A district may nominate up to two classified employees. The awardee is selected

by a committee comprised of past award recipients.

Requirement: The Classified Employee of the Year Nomination Form must be completed and

submitted with district support.
