Tier 1 - School-wide/Universal Systems

The training sequence is divided into 2 strands: Site Team Training (includes site/district PBIS Coach), and PBIS Coaches Training.

In order to participate, schools and districts must commit site and identify PBIS coach(es).

Site Teams and site/district PBIS Coaches **MUST** attend all School-Wide PBIS Trainings (4 days).

PBIS Coaches **MUST** attend all Coaches Trainings (4 days).
