

Tobacco Prevention Resources

The Marin County Office of Education (MCOE) continues to receive Countywide Technical Assistance & Leadership Funds (CTALF) to support districts for capacity building, training, evaluation and coordination of tobacco prevention activities. MCOE receives approximately \$37,500 annually to provide these services on a countywide basis.

Although the MCOE was not granted funding of the recent Tobacco Use and Prevention Education (TUPE) grant, we are focusing on being well-positioned for the next Request for Application (RFA). MCOE staff will work with districts to ensure all LEAs are Tobacco-Free Certified. If granted, this funding could bring approximately \$575,000 in resources to our students over a three year period. MCOE staff will be outreaching to districts individually to support completion of Tobacco-Free Certification by August 30th.
