Consulting with Pupils LCAPs shall include a process for enabling pupils to review and comment on the development of the LCAP. The process may include surveys, forums, pupil advisory committees, or meetings with pupil government bodies, like student councils. [CCR 15495(a)].

English Learner Advisory Groups Districts with at least 15% English learners, and at least 50 enrolled English learner pupils shall establish an English Learner Parent Advisory committee. The majority of the members must be parents of English learners. Existing committees with a similar makeup may be used.

Parent Advisory Committee Districts must establish a Parent Advisory Committee that's composed of a majority of parents. The Parent Advisory Committee shall also include the parents of English learners, low income and foster youth pupils. Existing committees with a similar makeup may be used.
