SUBJECT: Transportation Equalization Funding Proposal

SB191 introduces legislation for the second year in a row that would provide funding to districts and JPAs that are currently below 50% of their Home-to-School reimbursements. Below is a list of Marin agencies who would benefit from this proposal. If successful, this proposal would bring \$773,710 into Marin school districts.
