What is the Purpose of **SEAC**?

The purpose of the Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) is to provide school districts with input on the development and implementation of the Local Plan for special education. The SEAC offers a forum for addressing the needs of all students with disabilities. Through participation on the SEAC, members will become informed regarding special education policies and procedures, learn to advocate for the needs of children with disabilities, and have an opportunity to participate in decision making that impacts the delivery of special education services in Marin County.



Why Does **SEAC** Exist?

The Special Education Advisory Committee serves as a forum to actively participate in the delivery of special education services in Marin County by:

- ✓ Providing parents, educators, community members, and organizations with resources and information regarding the needs of students enrolled in special education;
- ✓ Improving communication and collaboration within the local school districts in Marin County, to positively impact students; and
- ✓ Advising the Marin County SELPA's Operational Steering Committee regarding special education issues.

What is a **SELPA**?

A Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA) is a group of school districts and County Office of Education that join together to form a geographic region to provide all of the special education service needs for children with disabilities residing within the region's boundaries. In Marin County, the SELPA consists of all of the local school districts and the Marin County Office of Education. The Marin County SELPA is a support service office. The SELPA is responsible to ensure that programs and services are available to meet the needs of students with disabilities from birth through age 22 in Marin County.
