DID YOU KNOW THAT DURING THE 2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR:

- Provided initial and ongoing Guided Language Acquisition by Design (GLAD) training to over 35 elementary teachers representing up to 7 districts, 8 middle school teachers, representing up to 5 districts and 9 administrators representing 6 districts.
- Over 400 people participated in the 2013-14 Speaker Series. Presenters included: Nikhil Goyal, George Couros, Gary Stager, and Milton Chen. Registrants included educators, administrators, community members, parents and agency representatives.
- North Bay CUE Marin was attended by 155 Marin County teachers in the fall, featuring teacherquided professional development with topics related to technology integration.
- Dr. Anita Archer, author and leader in professional development, provided presentations to 74 elementary and secondary teachers on academic vocabulary, engagement strategies, and incorporating English Language Development into curriculum.
- 30 Educators from Marin participated in a Project Based Learning series, sponsored by the Buck Institute for Education.
- Sexual Harassment training was conducted by Carl Corbin from College and Legal Services on behalf of all administrative personnel as well as board members.
- MCOE provided a series of Common Core State Standards trainings to all districts by Kathy Glass; 56 participated from 9 districts.
- MCOE held its first Administrator's Unconference to bring together administrators who shared ideas about what's happening or what they would like to see happen in education.
- 28 Elementary, middle school and special education MCOE teachers participated in Instructional Practicums where they observed highly qualified teachers in the classroom.
- 259 Marin County teachers participated in Beginning Teacher Support and Assessment (BTSA): 155 new teachers and 104 Support Providers.
- 68 new teachers completed their BTSA Induction Program requirements for a single or multiple subject credential.
- 10 new teachers completed their Level Two Special Education credentials.
- MCOE hosted "A Night for the Community: Understanding the Common Core State Standards" on January 28, 2014 with Kathy Glass presenting.

- Dr. Frank Donovan, Ed.D. presented on Common Core State Standards How do they apply to the Special Educator?
- EdCamps for Secondary Educators, Elementary Educators, Special Education Educators, Early Childhood Leaders were held throughout the year.
- Deaf/Hard of Hearing workshop was held by Nancy Sager on February 26, 2014.
- MCOE hosted a Smarter Balanced (SBAC) Field Test Workshop with Michael McDaniel from ETS on March 5, 2014.
- MCOE hosted a Mathematics Adoption Toolkit Training with Eileen Smith on March 6, 2014 in which 21 teachers from 8 districts attended.
- English Language Development Standards workshop was held with Pam Spycher from WestEd on March 18, 2014; 50 educators from 8 districts attended.
- Roundtable on Expulsion Appeal for District Administrators, with Robert Henry, Esq. occurred on March 18, 2014 for all districts.
- Crisis Prevention Institute training was held three times this year; special education teaching staffs were trained by MCOE special day class teachers, Cindy Evans and Melinda Stewart.
- Curriculum and Educational Technology Fair was held with 16 vendors on March 20, 2014.
- Early Learning Summit Be the Bridge to Learning, ECE program was held on March 22, 2014; 60 Early Childhood Educators of children 0 grade 2 participated.
- A Community Night: Standardized Testing for Parents, Students and Educators, presented by Dr. Gary Gruber on March 24, 2014.
- Arts Integration Series was held at MCOE in conjunction with Larkspur Corte Madera School District; 17 teachers attended the four workshops across the 13-14 school year.
- Over 30 practitioners were trained in Positive Parenting Program (Triple P); 3 trainings were held.
- Lucy Caulkins based workshop, Connecting Common Core State Standards, was held on March 24 and was attended by 29 educators; March 25, 2014 was attended by 43 educators.
- MCOE held a Special Education Showcase on April 29, with 17 exhibits.
- Hosted a Personalized Learning workshop on May 6. 14 administrators attended.
- Seizure Management training was held May 7 for Educators across Marin districts.
- MCOE & Autodesk held a workshop called Design the Future, Showcasing Fusion 360 on May 28, 2014.
- On June 23 the second Annual Countywide EdCamp was held at White Hill Middle School with 55 attendees.
- On June 24 the second Annual Summer Institute was held at White Hill Middle School with 50 attendees.
- Participated in the review of 19 district LCAPs in collaboration with Business Services.
