We are happy to report that MCOE approved all Marin County LCAPs within the statutory timeline to approve budgets. Congratulations to all of you. As you are aware, we worked closely with many districts throughout the spring and appreciate your work and dedication.

The Education Code allows for a formal clarification process, as communicated to boards. Because this process was the first year, we developed a strategy that worked toward the approvals and captured the technical assistance follow up that we are providing directly to district administration after approval. This technical assistance follow up is separated into two categories:

1. Technical misses that were not material to approval, given the first year of implementation
  - a. These items will need to be addressed and incorporated with your future updates
2. Technical assistance to use for future LCAP Updates; these are more guidance related and not connected to future approvals

We anticipate completing the technical assistance reports within the next week or two. They will be emailed to superintendents, chief business officials and instructional administrators. Additional feedback and support is offered for those of you who would like to meet with us to discuss and review this feedback. Once the technical assistance report is emailed out to you, please do not hesitate to let me know if you are interested in this additional follow up.

Again, your efforts and hard work has made it possible for our initial LCAP process to be a success and we truly thank you for your dedication and commitment.
