1220 CITIZEN'S COMMITTEES

The Superintendent/Governing Board may establish Citizen's Committees to advise the Superintendent/Governing Board regarding the Marin County Office of Education programs, services, or needs. The Superintendent/Governing Board shall give a Committee its specific charge including time span for the study and the offer of staff support and assistance. Each Committee shall be dissolved by the Superintendent/Governing Board at the conclusion of its charge.

Meetings of all committees appointed by the Governing Board shall be held pursuant to all applicable provisions of the Brown Act.
