## 4223 PROFESSIONAL GROWTH REQUIREMENTS: CLEAR MULTIPLE OR SINGLE SUBJECT TEACHING CREDENTIALS

It is the policy of the Superintendent/Governing Board to assume those duties and responsibilities prescribed to it by state law and regulations regarding the renewal of teaching credentials. It is the credential holders responsibility to develop and implement their individual professional growth plans in accordance with those duties and responsibilities prescribed to them by state law and regulations regarding the renewal of teaching credentials.

The Superintendent, or his/her designee, shall annually designate one or more professional growth advisors who may or may not be employees of the Marin County Office of Education. Professional growth advisors shall hold (a) a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution of post secondary education, and (b) a valid clear California teaching or services credential.

The Superintendent, or his/her designee, shall annually provide to each employee who holds a professional clear teaching credential a list of the names and work locations of persons who have been designated to serve as professional growth advisors.

The Superintendent, or his/her designee, shall be responsible for verifying on a credential holder's professional growth record when the credential holder successfully completes the professional service requirements of state law and regulations pertaining to professional service requirements for renewing a professional clear teaching credential.
