## 6350 SPECIAL EDUCATION – DUE PROCESS PROCEDURES

A pupil, parent, or public agency may initiate due process hearing procedures under any of the following circumstances:

1. There is a proposal to initiate or change the identification, assessment or educational placement of the child or the provision of a free, appropriate public education to the child.
2. There is a refusal to initiate or change the identification, assessment, or educational placement of the child or the provision of a free, appropriate public education to the child.
3. The parent refuses to consent to an assessment of the child.

Parents of individuals with exceptional needs shall be notified at least annually of their special education rights and due process procedures as specified in the California Education Code.

Complaints concerning compliance with special education laws shall be addressed under Marin County Office of Education's Uniform Complaint Procedures (Bd. Policy 1501).

There shall be compliance with state and federal laws and regulations regarding due process and complaint procedures.
