## TNSTRUCTION

## Instructional Media Center

- 1. The Marin County Superintendent of Schools shall establish, conduct, and maintain facilities which provide instructional media and equipment to contracting districts.
- 2. Films and filmstrips shall be adopted by the Marin County Board of Education before they are purchased by the County Superintendent of Schools.
- 3. The films and filmstrips listed in the Instructional Media catalog will indicate the recommended subject area and grade level.
- 4. The local district board, superintendent, and school principal have the responsibility to control the use of instructional media obtained from the Marin County Schools Instructional Media Center.
- 5. The local district board, superintendent, and school principals have the authority to obtain instructional media from sources other than the Marin County Schools Office Instructional Media Center.
