 8311 TRUSTEE AREAS

The trustee areas for the Board as determined by the Marin County Committee on School District Organization, pursuant to Education Code Sections 1000 and 1007 and reported to the Marin County Board of Supervisors on July 24, 1973 shall be constituted as follows:

Trustee Area Number 1 shall comprise all of the area within the boundaries described as follows: "That portion of the Novato Unified School District south and west of the boundary line of the Novato City limits starting from the most northeasterly point of Parcel No. 157-160-13, Assessor's Map, County of Marin, at the junction of the San Pablo Bay and Novato Creek; thence running along the Novato City limits line along the north bank of the Novato Creek westerly to State Highway 37; thence continuing westerly along the Novato City limits line to the center line of Highway 101 to the most southeasterly point of Marin County Official Voter Precinct No. 5200; thence running northwesterly along the southeasterly line of Marin County Official Voter Precinct No. 5200 to the point of intersection of Marin County Official Voter Precinct No. 5200 and the northerly side of Diablo Avenue; thence running northwesterly along Novato Boulevard to Reservoir Road including those residences on the north side of Novato Boulevard; thence continuing northwesterly on the center line of Novato Boulevard to a point where the southeasterly line of Marin County Official Voter Precinct No. 5221 crosses the center line of Novato Boulevard; thence along Marin County Official Voter Precinct No. 5221 line southerly, northwesterly, northerly, easterly and northerly to a point where the line of Marin County Official Voter Precinct No. 5221 crosses the center line of Novato Boulevard; thence running along the center line of Novato Boulevard northwesterly to a point where such line meets the Lincoln School District boundary line."

Trustee Area Number 2 shall comprise all of the area within the boundaries described as follows: "That portion of the San Rafael Elementary School District south of the northerly boundary line of the San Rafael City limits, running from San Pablo Bay westerly to a point where the San Rafael City limits line meets the easterly side of North San Pedro Road; thence continuing along the San Rafael City limits line southwesterly, northeasterly, and southeasterly to San Pablo Avenue; thence continuing southeasterly and westerly along the San Rafael City limits line to the center line of Highway 101; thence continuing southerly along the center line of Highway 101 to the intersection of Highway 101 and Mission Avenue; thence continuing along the center line of Mission Avenue westerly to the intersection of Mission Avenue and "H" Street; thence continuing along the center line of "H" Street southerly to the intersection of "H" Street and 4th Street; thence continuing westerly along the center line of 4th Street to the easterly

boundary line of the old San Anselmo School District thence running southerly, westerly, southerly, and easterly along the easterly boundary line of the old San Anselmo School District and continuing southeasterly along the northeasterly boundary line of Kentfield School District to the center line of State Highway 101; thence continuing along the center line of Highway 101 to the Corte Madera Creek; thence running easterly along the northerly boundary line of Larkspur City limits to the San Francisco Bay at San Quentin."

Trustee Area Number 3 shall comprise the Dixie School District, plus that portion of the San Rafael School District north of the boundary line described in Trustee Area No. 2.

Trustee Area Number 4 shall comprise the Kentfield, Ross, and old San Anselmo school districts.

Trustee Area Number 5 shall comprise the Larkspur, Reed Union, and that portion of the Mill Valley School District east of Highway 101.

Trustee Area Number 6 shall comprise Sausalito School District and Mill Valley School District less that portion east of Highway 101.

Trustee Area Number 7 shall comprise the B. Jones-Stinson Union, Shoreline School District, Redwood Union, Lincoln, Union Joint, Nicoya, Lagunitas and old Fairfax school districts, and the Novato Unified School District less that portion described in Trustee Area Number 1.
