Ad Hoc Committees appointed by the Board may meet in Study Sessions to examine matters of particular concern that necessitate prolonged discussion and deliberation prior to formal action by the Board. Unless the Ad Hoc Committees are composed of only members of the Board and constitute less than a quorum of the Board, all meetings of Ad Hoc Committees shall be held pursuant to applicable provisions of the Brown Act.

The agenda for each Ad Hoc Committee Study Session shall be posted in a location that is freely accessible to members of the public at least 72 hours before the Study Session.

The agenda shall state the date, time and location of the meeting and shall include a brief general description of each item to be discussed.

An Ad Hoc Committee Study Session is not a regularly called meeting of the Board, but a record of the proceedings may be kept.
