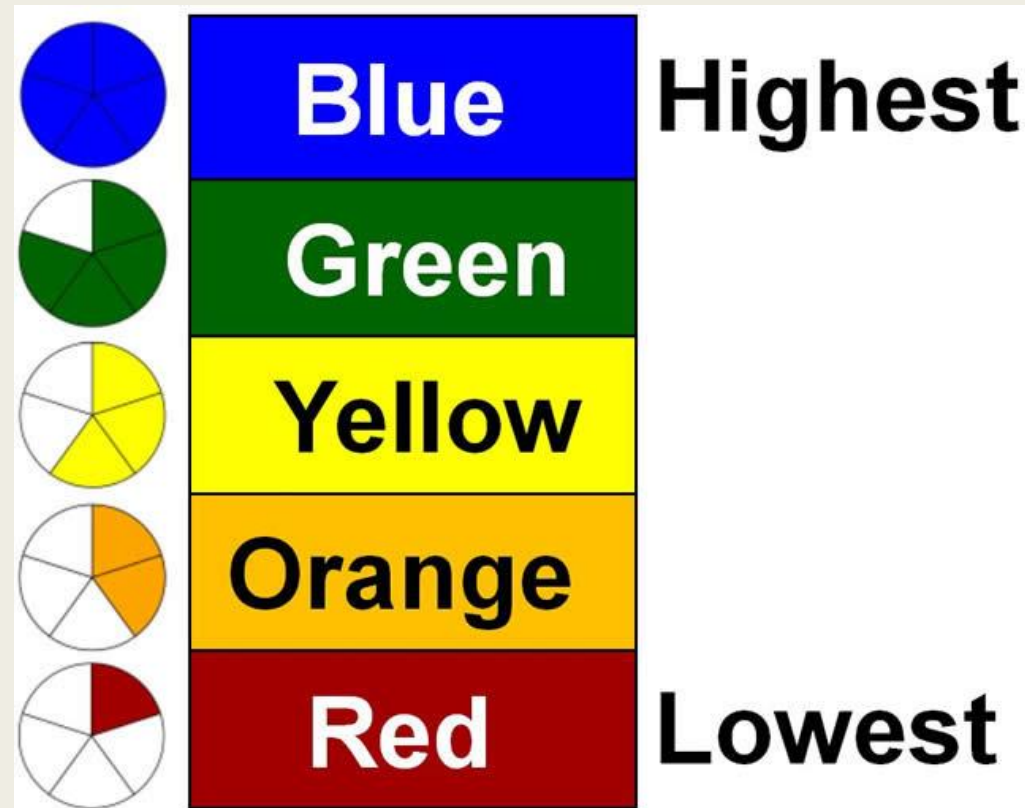

10 Indicators of School Success

State Indicators

- **SIX** indicators allow for comparisons across schools and districts.

- ★ High School Graduation Rate
- ★ Academic Performance
- ★ Suspension Rate

- Schools and districts receive **one of five color-coded performance levels** on each of the six state indicators.
