

Teacher Induction Credentialing Process from Registration to Recommendation

I. Eligibility Review:

- District Induction Coordinator works with District/Site HR to identify newly hired/current teachers that are eligible for Teacher Induction based on preliminary credential status
- Induction Coordinator/District/Site staff provide the registration information to eligible teachers
- Identified teachers register for the program through MCOE online registration

II. Candidate Review and Acceptance by Marin County Induction Program:

- 1. Marin County Teacher Induction Program reviews each teacher's credential on CTC website to determine program eligibility
- 2. To ensure accuracy of data in Step 1, MCOE Support Staff reviews candidate's credential requirements on CTC website and confirms eligibility
- 3. Teachers with additional credential requirements are emailed directly with resources, time-lines, and a specific follow up process
- 4. Marin County Teacher Induction Program offers and reviews submitted applications for Early Completion Option (ECO) for eligible candidates

III. Teacher completes 2-Year Teacher Induction Program OR ECO (if approved)

IV. At Program Completion:

- Marin County Induction Program confirms completion of induction requirements and CTC renewal requirements for each candidate
- Once requirements are met, Marin County Teacher Induction leadership makes recommendation for Clear Credential to CTC

(All credentialing processes outlined above are completed by MCOE Personnel)
