



Signs & Symptoms of a Low Blood Sugar (Hypoglycemia)

numbness of lips or tongue; headache; strange behavior; confusion; personality change; passing out; headedness or dizziness; hunger; drowsiness; stubbornness or combativeness; lack of coordination; blurred vision; nausea; tingling or Can include: shakiness; nervousness; sweating; irritability, sadness, or anger; impatience; chills and cold sweat; fast heartbeat; light-

Signs & Symptoms of a High Blood Sugar (Hyperglycemia)

blurry vision; warm, flushed skin; drowsiness; breathing problems; unconsciousness; Can include: nausea; vomiting; stomach pain; fruity-smelling breath; lack of appetite; frequent urination; extreme thirst; weakness;
