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Dear Parent/Guardian:

We are sending this letter because your child has not fulfilled the physical exam requirement for school entry. The state of California requires that by 90 days of first grade entry all students must have either a document signed by a doctor stating that the child has had a physical exam for school or have a waiver signed by the parent refusing the physical exam due to personal beliefs. In addition, this exam must not have been performed earlier than March of the year entering kindergarten, or 18 months prior to first grade entry. We recommend that the physical be completed prior to kindergarten entry when your child is receiving his/her required immunizations.

Your child has not met the physical exam requirement due to the following reason:

- No evidence of physical exam in school records
- Physical exam in school records is outside the acceptable time frame stated above.
- Your child will be excluded as of _____ if physical exam is not received.

Students are eligible for a free health exam if their family income falls within a certain range established by the State of California Child Health Disability Prevention Program (CHDP). Please contact the CHDP office at 473-4269 for more information or call the school nurse at your child's school for assistance in scheduling this exam.
