Update on the California Early Childhood Mentor Program, Mentor Director project: There is about \$3,200 to pay for a Coordinator of the project. The role of this position is to identify qualified Directors to participate in Director Mentor Institutes/trainings, support and connect them with other Directors as mentors. The training institutes are paid for by the California Early Childhood Mentor Program which also pays Mentor Directors an hourly stipend for their services as mentors. The Coordinator would report to Michelle St. Germaine, Assistant Director of the Mentor Program (housed at Chabot College in Hayward).

Peggy will confirm that funds for the Director Mentor Coordinator do not impact the College of Marin Mentor Teacher program. Peggy will also confirm the role of the Coordinator.

The Projecting into the Future conversation was tabled as we are still awaiting confirmation of funding and terms.

Consortia partners voted to hire CSCCE to provide the Workforce Study Data for Marin County using the data collected for the SEQUAL. The Workforce Study data is specific to compensation and will be available to us in June 2020. The cost is \$12,000 and will be paid for with First 5 Marin funds left over from the SEQUAL study.
